PRE-TEEN & YOUTH PROGRAMMES

THE GRIT Academy+

*Mentoring

A 7-8 months mentoring programme that seek to support children ages 11 to 13 as they go through social, physical and structural transitions. The children embark on a journey of self-discovery and growth with the mentors alongside, serving as their positive role models.



School Social Work (Pri & Sec)

Our programmes are designed to help students develop positive problem-solving skills and socio-emotional skills through interactive workshops and experiential activities. Programmes will be customised based on individual school needs.
