Plus, we introduced a volunteer tutor for her eldest son.

Last year, the family received the Christmas love gift through our Season of Giving campaign, which they used to share a rare family meal together.



Today, we continue to support this family. The couple is committed to providing the best possible care for the children, and supporting each other during challenging moments.
